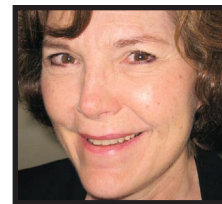

The anatomy of an abusive relationship

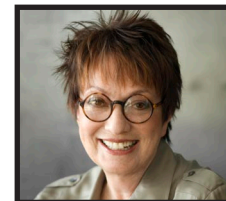
